

# Varsity Boys End Regular Season 23-2

The varsity boys basketball team ended their regular season Friday, Feb. 28 with a big victory over the Bourbon Warhawks. The varsity team finish their regular season with a 23-2 record and a 10-0 GVC record.

The Eagles got off to a slow start with Bourbon stalling most of the game. Vienna led 6-5 at the end of the first quarter but held Bourbon to only three points in the second quarter to take a 24-8 lead at half-time. The Eagles extended their lead in the second half outscoring the Warhawks 37-27 to take a 61-35 victory. The Eagles led by as much as 40 points at one point in the game.

Jason Roberson had a hot night for the Eagles pouring in 21 points, including five 3-pointers, 2-2 FT, 3 rebounds. Neil Copeland, 12 points (one 3-pointer), 1-1 FT, 5 assists, 5 steals, 4 rebounds; Chris Helton, 9 points, 1-2 FT, 2 assists, 5 rebounds; John Schwartze, 6 points, 4 assists, 4 rebounds;

Jarret Struempf, 5 points, 1-2 FT, 4 assists, 1 steal, 4 rebounds; Jeff Stricklan, 5 points, 2 steals, 6 rebounds; Shaun Potter, 2 points, 3 assists, 4 rebounds; Chad Russell, 2 steals, 1 blocked shot, 4 rebounds; and Jimmy Buschmann, 1 assist, 2 steals and 6 rebounds.

Bourbon shot 12-55 from the field for 22%, 6-10 from the free throw line for 60% and pulled down 20 rebounds. Jason Merkel scored 12 points for the Warhawks.

Vienna shot 24-47 from the field for 51% and 8-14 from the free throw line, 57%. The Eagles pulled down 40 rebounds and had 12 steals.
