Attend National FHA Cluster Meeting

Eight members of the Vienna Chapter of the Future Homemakers of America recently participated in a weekend leadership training conference held in Louisville, KY, Nov. 22-24, 1996.

The Louisville meeting was the fifth in a series of five nationally sponsored training conferences, called Cluster Meetings, held this fall.

The group traveled by chartered bus with approximately 150 other FHA members from Region 13 in central Missouri. The students earned funds for the trip

through selling projects and a bake sale. The support of these projects from the community is very much appreciated by the FHA members. Without it the chapter would not be able to carry out such leadership activities.
