

Varsity Boys Win Six Straight Games

The Vienna High School varsity boys basketball team made it six straight wins Friday night with a win over the Steelville Cardinals.

The Eagles trailed 10-11 after the first quarter and 19-25 at halftime, but outscored the Cardinals 30-22 in the second half to take a 49-47 win.

Chad James led the Eagles with 15 points (7/8 free throws), 5 rebounds, 2 steals, 2 assists, 3 blocked shots; Tony James, 9 points, 3 rebounds, 1 steal, 3 assists, 1 blocked shot; Mitch Wieberg, 9 points, 2 rebounds, 1

steal, 1 assist; Tyler Schwartze, 8 points, 4 rebounds, 3 steals, 4 assists, 1 blocked shot; Sam Barnhart, 6 points, 3 rebounds, 1 assist; Kenneth Roberson, 2 points, 1 assist; Korbey Canuto, 2 rebounds, 1 assist; and Nathan Copeland, 1 rebound, 1 assist.

The Eagles also defeated the Bourbon Warhawks 59-51 last Tuesday, Jan. 11 in conference action.

Tony James had a big night for the Eagles as he poured in 22 points (two 3-pointers), 5 assists, 3 rebounds; Chad James, 14 points, 2 assists, 5 blocked shots,

5 rebounds; Sam Barnhart, 5 points, 2 assists, 4 rebounds, 1 steal; Korbey Canuto, 5 points, 1 assist; Mitch Wieberg, 4 points, 2 assists, 2 blocked shots, 8 rebounds, 1 steal; Tyler Schwartze, 4 points, 2 assists, 2 rebounds, 7 steals; Kenneth Roberson, 3 points (one 3-pointer), 1 rebound; Nathan Copeland, 2 points, 3 rebounds; Tristan Lopes, 1 assist, 1 blocked shot; and Justin Helton, 1 steal, 1 rebound.

The Eagles are now 9-4 overall (2-1 in the conference).
