

Girls Fall To Crocker

The Vienna High School girls varsity basketball team dropped their second game of the year with a 49-58 loss to the Crocker Lions Thursday, Jan. 13.

"We were slow and tentative. We didn't play good defense and shot miserably," said head coach Mick Byrd. "It also didn't help that Crocker shot over twice as many free throws as we did. Imagine that happening at Crocker!"

The girls shot 18/69 from the field (24%) and 5/10 from the free throw line (50%).

Vienna trailed 7-9 after the first quarter and 19-26 at the half. Crocker outscored the Eagles 32-30 in the second half to capture the win.

Monica Slone led the Eagles with 17 points (one 3-pointer), 7 rebounds, 2 steals; Amy Hollis, 14 points (four 3-pointers), 4 rebounds, 1 steal, 6 assists, 1 blocked shot; Kelly Steinman, 7 points, 4 rebounds, 2 steals, 1 assist; Jenny Fick, 6 points (two 3-pointers), 1 rebound; Laurie Snodgrass, 5 points (one 3-pointer), 1 rebound, 1 assist; Erin Henderson, 1 rebound; and Amanda Juergens, 5 rebounds, 1 steal, 3 assists.

Vienna is now 9-2 overall (3-0 in the conference).
