In first round action, #5 seed Vienna fell to #4 seed Fatima 14-46. The Eagles were shut out in the first quarter.

Vienna 39, Fatima 9th 31

In second round action, the Eagles defeated the Fatima 9th

grade team 39-31. Vienna led 18-17 at halftime.

Vienna 36, Eldon 43

In the consolation game the Eagles faced #6 seed Eldon and dropped a 36-43 decision.

pointer), 1 rebound, 1 steal, 1 assist; Ellie Byrd, 7 points (one 3-pointer), 4 rebounds, 1 steal, 5 assists; Diane Weider, 4 points, 1 rebound, 1 steal, 1 assist; Adria Weakly, 2 points, 3 rebounds, 3 steals; Tasha Sandbothe, 4 points, 1 rebound, 2 steals, 3 assists; Tori Woods, 1 point, 5 rebounds, 2 steals, 1 blocked shot; Holly Schwartze, 1 point, 1 rebound; Amanda Stratman, 1 point, 2 rebounds, 2 steals; and Sarah Henderson, 1 steal, 1 assist.

Vienna shot 12/50 from the field (24%) and 8/17 from the free throw line (49%). Eldon shot 16/29 from the free throw line (56%).
