

Varsity Girls Edge Bourbon

The Vienna High School varsity girls basketball team managed to edge Bourbon last

Thursday, Feb. 17 in Gasconade Valley Conference action.

Vienna trailed 28-31 at halftime and 40-43 heading into the final quarter, but the Lady Eagles hit crucial free throws at the end of the game to escape

with a 63-61 win.

Monica Slone led the Lady Eagles with 25 points, 7 rebounds, 1 steal; Amy Hollis, 17 points (one 3-pointer), 6 rebounds, 8 steals, 3 assists; Kelly Steinman, 8 points (one 3-pointer), 3 rebounds, 1 steal; Laurie Snodgrass, 7 points (one 3-pointer), 3 rebounds, 2 steals, 4 assists; Jenny Fick, 2 points, 1 steal, 2 assists; Erin Henderson, 2 points, 3 rebounds, 1 steal, 1 assist; Ellie Byrd, 2 points, 1 steal, 2 assists; and Amanda Juergens, 4 rebounds, 3 steals, 1 assist.

Vienna shot 18/58 from the field (31%) and 24/36 from the free throw line (67%).

"Jenny Fick and Monica Slone hit crucial free throws at the end of the game," said head coach Mick Byrd. "We had three players foul out. We didn't shoot well and didn't play very good defense at all, but we still managed to get the win. Our players showed a lot of character. If you just keep playing, you've always got a shot at pulling out a victory!"
