

JV Girls Fall To Iberia By Three

The Vienna High School junior varsity girls basketball team lost their final game of the season Monday, Feb. 21 against Iberia.

The score was tied 10-10 after the first quarter but the Lady Eagles took a 27-20 lead at halftime. The Rangers came out strong in the second half, outscoring the Lady Eagles 33-21 to take a 53-50 win.

Diane Weider led the Lady Eagles with 12 points, 2 rebounds; Natalie Thornton, 11 points (one 3-pointer), 4 rebounds, 2 steals, 4 assists; Amanda Stratman, 9 points, 4 rebounds, 2 steals, 4 assists; Holly Schwartze, 5 points, 2 rebounds, 1 steal, 1 assist; Tori Woods, 4 points, 6 rebounds; Adria Weakly, 4 points, 3 rebounds, 3 steals, 1 assist; Sarah Henderson, 2 points, 3 rebounds, 1 steal, 1 assist; Tasha Sandbothe, 2 points, 3 rebounds; and Jessica Honse, 1 point, 1 rebound.

Vienna shot 20/57 from the field (37%) and 9/24 from the

free throw line (38%).

"It was one of our best JV games of the year," said head coach Mick Byrd. "Fifty points is a lot of points to score. We did a lot of good things. Our players showed a lot of improvement during the season and played with a lot of grit and determination. I am proud of them."

The junior varsity girls ended their season with an 11-8 record and a second place finish in the Gasconade Valley Conference.
