

Girls Win First Round Game In District Tourney

The Vienna High School varsity girls basketball team won their first round game in the Class 2A District Basketball Tournament Saturday, Feb. 26 at Licking.

The #3 seed Eagles defeated #6 seed Dixon 68-51 after leading 34-26 at the half.

Amy Hollis hit four 3-pointers in the contest. She finished the game with 22 points and 2 rebounds. Monica Slone added 21 points, 9 rebounds, 3 steals and 1 assist. Amanda Juergens, 9 points, 2 rebounds, 3 steals, 2 assists; Kelly Steinman, 6 points, 5 rebounds, 2 steals, 2 assists; Debra Lee Snodgrass, 6 points, 2 rebounds, 1 steal; Jenny Fick, 2 points, 1 rebound, 1 assist; Ellie Byrd, 2 points, 1 assist; Erin Henderson, 1 rebound, 2 steals, 3 assists; Laurie Snodgrass, 1 assist; and Rebecca Henderson, 1 rebound.

Vienna shot 24/42 from the field (57%) and 16/21 from the free throw line (76%).

"We played a very solid game and shot the ball really well," said head coach Mick Byrd. "It was a good win."

The girls played Licking Tuesday, Feb. 29 in the semi-final contest. The winner of that game will play for the District Championship against the winner of the Conway-Hartville game.

The varsity girls improve to 19-7 on the season.
