The Vienna High School baseball team fell to the St. Elizabeth Hornets 13-8 on March 27.

St. Elizabeth took an early 1-0 lead after the first inning. The Eagles scored 7 runs in the top of the third but the Hornets answered back in their half of the third, scoring 7 runs.

The Hornets added 2 runs in the fourth, 1 in the fifth and 2 more in the sixth. Vienna could only manage 1 more run in the fifth as St. Elizabeth took a 13-8 victory.

Vienna scored 8 runs off 10 hits while St. Elizabeth scored 13 runs off 8 hits. The Eagles committed 7 errors while the Hornets committed 2.

Offensive leaders for the Eagles were Tyler Willoughby,

4 at bats, 2 hits, 2 runs scored; John Wulff, 4 at bats, 3 hits, 1 run scored, 1 RBI; Mitch Wieberg, 4 at bats, 2 hits, 1 run scored, 2 RBIs; and Tom Haller, 3 at bats, 1 hit and 2 RBIs.

Sam Barnhart and Tyler Schwartze did the pitching, giving up 8 hits, 4 walks and 6 earned runs while striking out 3.

"The team had a mental letdown," said head coach Glen Dothage. "We were not ready to play. We followed every miscue by making a second one. We snowballed out mistakes which made for a long evening. Hopefully, we've got this out of our system."

The Eagles are now 1-1 overall (1-0 in the GVC).
