

# Vienna Defeats New Bloomfield

The Vienna High School baseball team defeated New Bloomfield 12-10 on April 7.

New Bloomfield took an early 1-0 lead after the first inning. Vienna scored 1 in the bottom of the second to tie the score 1-1. New Bloomfield added another run in their half of the third to lead 2-1 but the Eagles scored 3 times in their half of the third to take a 4-2 lead.

New Bloomfield bounced back in the top of the third, scoring 3 runs and taking a 5-4 lead. They scored 3 more runs in the fifth and 1 more in the sixth to take a 9-4 lead.

The Eagles did not give up.

They scored 3 runs in the bottom of the sixth to bring the game 9-7. New Bloomfield added another run in the top of the seventh to take a 10-7 lead. The Eagles had a big seventh inning, scoring 5 runs and taking a 12-10 victory.

The Eagles scored 12 runs off 13 hits while New Bloomfield scored 10 runs off 11 hits. Each team committed 2 errors.

Offensive leaders for the Eagles were Tyler Willoughby, 5 at bats, 2 hits (double), 3 runs scored; John Wulff, 5 at bats, 3 doubles, 3 runs scored, 2 RBIs; Abe Rowden, 5 at bats, one double, 4 RBIs and one home run; Tyler Schwartze, 3 at bats, 1 home run; and Sam Barnhart, 4 at bats, 2 double, 1 home run.

Mitch Wieberg, Tyler Schwartze and Tom Haller did the pitching, giving up 11 hits, 7 earned runs and 6 walks while striking out 5.

"It was great to the players to come back and win this game after being down in the late innings," said head coach Glen Dothage. "They showed a lot of determination."

The Eagles are now 4-2 overall (3-0 in the GVC).
