

Eagles Fall To Russellville

The Vienna High School baseball team dropped a 15-11 decision to the Russellville Indians on April 10.

The score was tied 1-1 after the first inning, but Vienna took a 3-1 lead after the third. Russellville came right back, scoring 3 runs in the top of the fourth and 6 runs in the top of the fifth to take a 10-3 lead. Vienna added 2 runs in the bottom of the fifth and 4 runs in the bottom of the sixth to trail 9-10. The Indians added 5 runs in the top of the seventh and the Eagles could only manage 2 runs in the bottom of the seventh.

Mitch Wieberg was the offensive leader with 4 at bats, 2 hits (double and triple), and 3 runs scored.

Tommy Haller took the loss for the Eagles, giving up 13 hits and 10 walks while striking out 5.

"It's tough to win when you issue 10 free passes," said head coach Glenn Dothage.

The Eagles scored 11 runs off 12 hits while the Indians scored 15 runs off 13 hits. Vienna had 14 errors while Russellville had 3.

The Eagles are now 4-3 overall.
