1600M Run: Crystal Wilson, 4th place, 5:53.

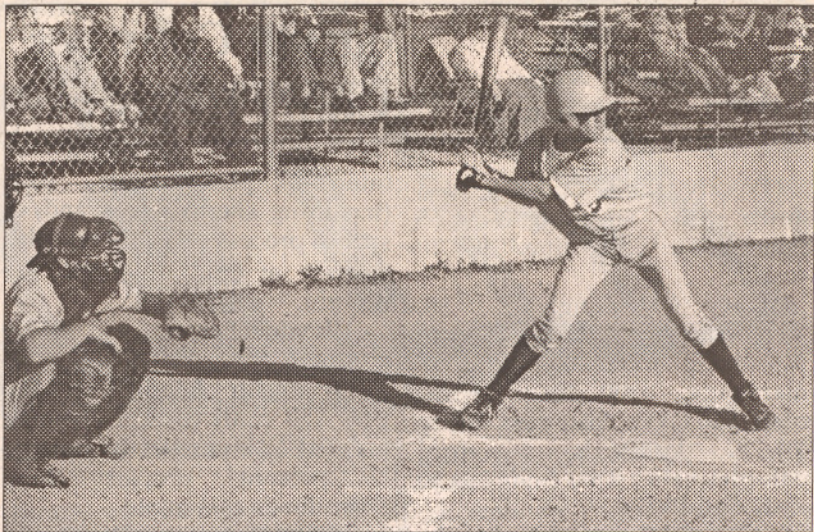
400M Dash: Laurie Snodgrass, 4th place, 64.63.
