The Vienna High School varsity boys baseball team outslugged Steelville on April 27, winning 18-14 after trailing by 7 runs early in the game.

Steelville scored 5 runs in the bottom of the first and two in the bottom of the second to take the early 7-0 lead.

Vienna scored 3 runs in the top of the third to bring the score 7-3, Steelville.

Steelville answered back, scoring 3 in the bottom of the third to take a 10-3 lead.

Vienna came back, scoring 3 runs in the top of the fourth and 7 runs in the top of the fifth to take 13-10 lead.

Steelville scored 2 runs in the bottom of the fifth to trail 12-13.

Vienna scored 3 more in the top of the sixth and 2 in the top of the seventh to take an 18-12

lead.

The Cardinals could only manage 2 runs in their half of the seventh, to fall 14-18.

Offensive leaders for the Eagles were: John Wulff, 1 at bat, 3 runs scored; Abe Rowden, 2 at bats, 1 double, 1 home run, 3 runs scored, 5 RBI's; Tyler Schwartz, 4 at bats, 1 home run, 1 run scored; and Sam Barnhart, 3 at bats, 1 hit, 1 home run, 3 RBI's.

Tyler Schwartz, Tommy Haller and Justin Helton combined to do the pitching.

"The team did a good job coming back after being down 7-0," said head coach Glenn Dothage. "Justin Helton did a good pitching job to close the game."

The Eagles are now 7-4 overall (4-0 in the conference).
