The Vienna High School baseball team won the Gasconade Valley Conference Championship on May 9 after edging past the Bourbon Warhawks 7-6.

Vienna got on the scoreboard, with two runs in the second inning. Bourbon came back with three runs in the third. Both team scored two runs in the fourth to make the score 5-4, Bourbon.

The Eagles brought three people across home n the sixth to take a 7-5 lead. Bourbon added another in the sixth, but couldn't score anymore as the Eagles won 7-6.

Offensive leaders for the Eagles were: Abe Rowden, 4 at bats, 2 hits; Mitch Wieberg, 2 at bats, 2 hits (double and home

run), 2 runs scored, 3 RBI's; Tyler Schwartz, 4 at bats, 2 hits; Tommy Haller, 4 at bats, 2 hits; and Justin Helton, 3 at bats, 2 hits.

Tommy Haller was the winning pitcher for the Eagles, giving up 10 hits and no walks while striking out 7.

"The team overcame some mistakes to come back and win this game which gave them the GVC Championship," said head coach Glenn Dothage. "Our offense and defense clicked and the players showed a lot of determination to get this win. The players and coach would like to thank our fans for their support."

The Eagles are now 7-5 overall (5-0 in the GVC).
