Lips (extemp. and duet), Missy Miller (original oratory), and Kelley Weidinger (humorous interp. and dramatic interp.).

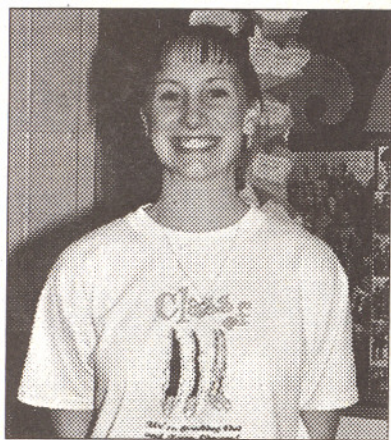
Both Kelley Weidinger and Rebecca Henderson made the finals and Rebecca went on to win first place in storytelling. She will be going to the state competition in April.
