

Girls finish third at Linn

■ Weidinger breaks Pole Vault record

The Vienna High School girls track team finished third in the 8-team Linn Invitational Track Meet last Thursday, April 5.

Team scores were: (1) Linn 198, (2) Blair Oaks 153, (3) Vienna 119, (4) Iberia 64, (5) New Bloomfield 59, (6) St. Elizabeth 26, (7) South Callaway 24 and (8) Chamois 1.

"We are battling some injuries and illnesses right now," said head coach Mick Byrd. "The kids who were physically able to compete did a very good job. We had several season best performances. The highlight was Kelley Weidinger's record breaking performance in the Pole Vault. Also, seniors Amanda Juergens and Debra Lee Snodgrass came close to records in the 100M Hurdles and the Shot Put."

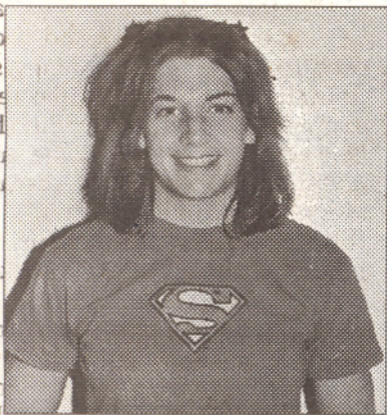
