

# Lady Eagles take 2nd in GVC Meet

## ■ Juergens, Snodgrass & Weidinger earn All-GVC

The Vienna High School girls track team took second place last Saturday at the Gasconade Valley Conference Track Meet held in Steelville. Final team scores were (1) Cuba 153.3, (2) Vienna 143.3, (3) Steelville 128, (4) Viburnum 54 and (5) Belle 31.

"Our athletes competed very hard and did everything they could to win the meet," said head coach Mick Byrd. "We just didn't have enough athletes, particularly healthy ones. I'm proud of the way we fought on Saturday."
