

Lady Eagles finish third at District track meet

■ Three headed to State meet in Jefferson City

The Vienna High School girls track team finished their season with a third place finish at the Class 1A District Track Meet held Saturday, May 12 at Missouri School for the Deaf in Fulton.

Final team scores were (1) St. Genevieve Valley Catholic 171, (2) New Haven 97, (3) Vienna 94, (4) St. Louis Eskridge 48, (5) St. Elizabeth 44, (6) Wellsville 39, (7) MSD of Fulton 31, (8) Oran 19, (9) Prairie Home and Chamois 0.

The highlight of the meet for the girls was qualifying three

athletes for the prestigious 1A-2A State Track Meet which will be held this Friday and Saturday, May 18 and 19 in Jefferson City. To qualify, it was necessary to finish in the top two in an event.

Senior Debra Lee Snodgrass qualified in two events, winning the Shot Put with a throw of 33' 3 1/2 and finishing second in the Discus with a throw of 91'7.

Senior Amanda Juergens finished second in the 100M Hurdles with a time of 17.56 to qualify for state.

Crystal Wilson finished second in the 3200M Run with a time of 12:59 to qualify for the state meet.

The State Track Meet will be run on Friday, May 18 and Saturday, May 19 at Dwight T. Reed Stadium on the Lincoln University campus in Jefferson City.

Juergens will run in the preliminaries of the 100M Hurdles at 12:30 p.m. on Friday.

Snodgrass will compete in the Shot Put preliminaries at 2:00 p.m. on Friday. She will also compete in the Discus

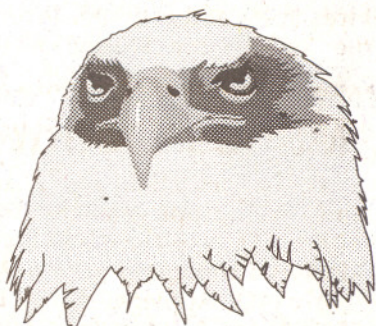
