# Varsity boys win consolation trophy in Eugene Tournament

The high school boys basketball team won the consolation trophy at the annual Eugene Tournament this past

weekend.

In first round action on Nov. 27, the #6 seed Eagles lost to #3 seed Russellville 62-53. Sam Barnhart was the top scorer with 15 points, 5 rebounds and 9

assists.

Other top scorers were Tyler Willoughby, 11 points, 4 rebounds, 5 assists; Justin Helton, 9 points, 12 rebounds, 6 blocked shots; and Matt Slone, 7 points.

The boys beat #7 seed St. Elizabeth in second round action on Nov. 28. The score was 68-54. Tyler Willoughby was the top scorer with 17 points and 4 steals.

Other top scorers were: Justin Helton, 15 points, 5 rebounds, 3 blocked shots; Sam Hagan, 10 points, 8 rebounds; T.C. James, 10 points, 9 rebounds; and Sam Barnhart, 7 points, 5 rebounds, 9 assists.

In the consolation game on Nov. 30, the Eagles defeated #8 seed California 62-47, thanks in part to shooting 26/35 from the free throw line.

Justin Helton led the Eagles with 25 points and 17 rebounds. Other high scorers were: Tyler Willoughby, 17 points; Sam Barnhart, 10 points, 12 assists; and Sam Hagan, 8 points.

As of December 3, the varsity boys are 3-1 overall.
