

Cross Country girls place second, boys place fourth

Medals were awarded to the

top 15 individuals. Results are as follows:

Junior Varsity Boys - Romain Garcia, 2nd place, 18:43; Bob Surminski, 24th place, 21:04; Tim Weakly, 25th place, 21:09; Blake Rowden, 43rd place, 23:33; and Brett Alexander 25:31.

Clayton Weidinger was the only boy to run varsity. He placed 56th with a time of 20:19.

Team scores for the girls were 1) Licking 75, 2) Vienna 105, 3) Southern Boone 113, 4) Fatima 136.

Junior varsity boys team scores were: 1) Rolla 38, 2) Fatima 50, 3) Licking 88, and 4) Vienna 141.
