third place; and Tyler Willoughby, sixty-fourth place.

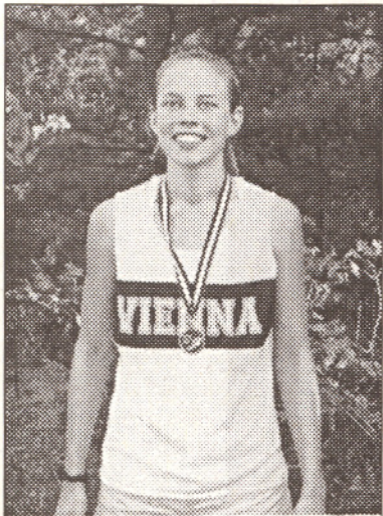
Coach Chuck Woody says that he is very pleased with all the runners. These are his comments.
