Hutchison selected to National FFA Chorus

David Hutchison, son of Barry and Patty Hutchison and a member of the Vienna FFA Chapter, was selected to the National FFA Chorus for the National Convention this fall. The FFA Chorus is made up of 100 members selected from approximately 2,000 applicants. The National Chorus meets a week before National Convention starts, to start rehearsing for their performances before the 46,000 FFA members, parents and guests that attend the

convention each year. FFA Chorus members must complete an application and audition tape, these must be sent to the selection committee prior to July 1 of each year.

David is the first member of the Vienna FFA Chapter to be selected to the national FFA Chorus. The Chorus director is Patti LaJoye from Hastings, Michigan. The Ford Division - Ford Motor Company of Detroit, Michigan sponsors the National Chorus as a special project of
