

JV ends season with 12-6 record

The Vienna High School junior varsity girls basketball team ended their fine season with a 12-6 record as they got past Iberia last Monday, February 18 with a 57-51 win. Vienna led 29-23 at the half.

Kacey Huffman had an explosive game as she ripped the nets for 19 points and pulled down 11 big rebounds. She also went 5/6 at the free throw line and had 1 steal.

Kacie Gibson also had a good night as she scored 15 points, 5/11 FT, 3 rebounds, 4 steals, 5 assists.

Other scorers were: Kelley Wieberg, 10 points, 0/3 FT, 5 rebounds, 5 steals, 1 assist; Jamie Sandbothe, 9 points, 3/6 FT, 6 rebounds, 4 steals; Tasha Sandbothe, 3 points, 1/2 FT, 3 rebounds, 3 steals, 1 assist;

Lacey Baxter, 1 point, 1/2 FT, 3 rebounds; Holly Schwartz, 1 rebound, 2 steals; Casey Steinman, 0/1 FT, 5 rebounds, 3 steals, 1 assist; Emily Miller, 0/1 FT, 1 rebound, 1 steal; Kelly Vogt, 1 rebound, 1 steal, 1 blocked shot; and Whitney Schoene, 3 rebounds.

Vienna shot 21/61 from the field (34%) and 15/32 from the free throw line (47%).

"We won our last six games in a row," said Head Coach Mick Byrd. "Our JV kids played a very solid game to end their season. We finished 12-6 overall and 8-2 in the conference. They made a lot of progress during the season. They played hard and they played together. They are good Vienna kids. It was fun to coach them."
