then work as a carpenter).

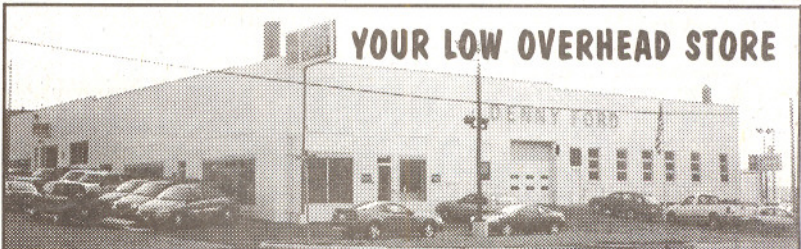
Teacher: Ellie Byrd plans to attend East Central College in Union on a softball scholarship and major in education.
