

Boys finish third at Belle

The Vienna High School boys track team traveled to Belle on Thursday, April 11. There, they placed third behind Cuba and Hermann.

Justin Helton had an incredible day, placing second in the Long Jump (19'3), first in the High Jump (5'6), first in the Shot Put (42'7), and first in the Discus (144' 2 1/4). Justin was within two feet of the school record in the Discus. A throw of 144'5' won State last year. Hopefully he'll keep it up for another month."
