

Girls finish high at Fatima Relays

The Vienna High School girls track team competed among 19 teams for the team title last Tuesday at the annual Fatima Blue & Gold Relays.

Due to darkness (the scorekeeper couldn't see her numbers!) final results were not immediately available, but it is believed by Coach Mick Byrd that the Lady Eagles finished fifth.

Points were awarded to the top eight finishers. Medals were awarded to the top six finishers in each individual event and to the top four relay teams.

The 4x800M Relay team continued their late season push for excellence with a second place finish in 10:56. Relay members were Lindsay Helton, Crystal Wilson, Ellie Byrd and Whitney Wieberg. Freshman

anchor Whitney Wieberg outkicked the Blair Oaks anchor runner in a very exciting finish.

Crystal Wilson finished third in the 1600M Run in a season best 5:57 and also took third in a season best 3200M Run in 12:38.

Whitney Wieberg took fourth in the 400M Dash in a personal best 65.74.

Freshman Kelley Wieberg finished seventh in the High Jump with a leap of 4'8.

Sophomore Lindsay Helton just missed a medal as she finished seventh in the 3200M Run in a time of 14:27.

"Teamwise, our field events people didn't have a very good day overall. Our medal winners did a great job, several running personal bests. Our 4x800 relay is looking pretty sharp," said Byrd.
