

# SB girls fall at Stoutland

Tigers 13-11. Amanda Stratman and Amanda Henderson combined to do the pitching. Stratman threw 2 innings, giving up 3 earned runs, 6 hits and 4 walks, while striking out none. Henderson, who picked up the win, threw 2 innings, giving up 1 earned run, 2 hits, and 3 walks while striking out 1. At one point Vienna trailed 10-1 but fought back to earn the victory. The Eagles scored 9 runs in the 4th inning. The big blow was a 2 run double by Lacey Baxter. Kelly Vogt was 2 for 3 with 2 RBI's. Kacie Gibson had 1 hit and 2 RNI's.
