and Crystal Wagner, 2nd in Duet Acting. Pat Rapert and David Martin helped judge the meet.

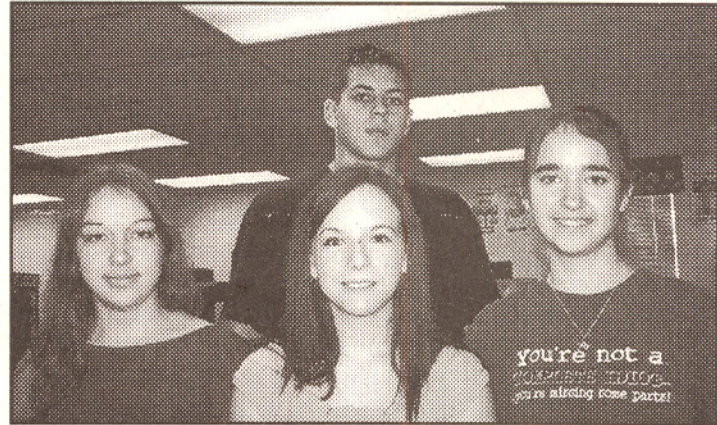

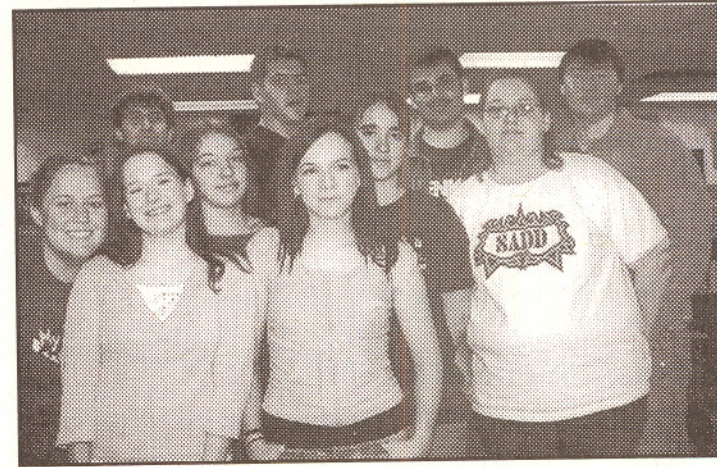
Theater Dept. will present "Register Here" March 9 & 10
