Schiermeier was the winning pitcher, giving up 10 hits and 3 walks while striking out 6.

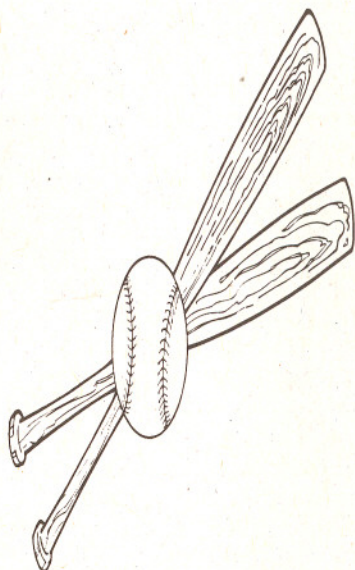
The varsity record is now 2-3.
