

# Varsity girls drop two, junior varsity splits

■ *Jennifer Vogt throws no hitter at Dixon*

The Blair Oaks Falcons blanked the Vienna Lady Eagles 10-0 in both games Monday, Sept. 26 in a makeup game for an early season rainout.

In the varsity game, Amanda Helton, Sarah French, Leann Stratman and Laurel Kingery each had 1 hit. Hannah Schiermeier did the pitching.

In the junior varsity game, Elaina James, Elizabeth Stratman and Brittany Franks each had 1 hit. Jennifer Vogt and Hayley Huffman did the pitching.

In Thursday's action at Dixon, the varsity team played a mistake ridden game and were finally edged by the Lady Bulldogs 7-6 on an unearned run in the bottom of the 7th inning.

Schiermeier was the losing pitcher, giving up 6 earned runs on 1 walk and 4 strikeouts. She gave up 9 hits.

Both Kingery and Schiermeier had 3 hits on offense. Stratman, Emily Page, Rachel Meyer, Huffman and Katie Henderson each added 1 hit.

In the JV game at Dixon, freshman pitcher Jennifer Vogt threw a no-hitter as the Lady Eagles edged the Lady Bulldogs 2-0.

Vienna scored their 2 runs in the first inning on a single by Jennifer Stratman, who stole 2nd and 3rd, a walk to Elizabeth Thornton, who stole 2nd and RBI groundouts by James and Vogt.
