SECRETARY'S REPORT

A motion was made by Rolanda Backues to accept the minutes from the October meeting, seconded by Carol Falter. Motion passed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Susan Brunnert distributed copies of the current fiscal year's account activity report. At present, the Club has a total of \$18,685.57 in their combined accounts, with \$9,538.96 in the checking account, \$5,623.93 in the MMDA and \$3,522.68 in the gym account. Bills pending include the pom poms (\$265), blankets, stadium seats (\$889) and an ad in the paper to thank the businesses (\$60).

MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

The membership drive is at a record high. So far we have a total of \$1,450 for businesses.

BLACK OUT T-SHIRTS

We have an order for 96 more adult shirts and 6 youth shirts. The minimum order is 12, so we will order 12 youth shirts. There is a price break at 100, so we will for sure order 100 adult shirts since we are so close. If there is another price break above 100 we will go ahead and order extra shirts. The black out dates are January 7 against Viburnum and February 8 against Belle. December 14 will not be a black out date.

STADIUM SEATS

The price did go up for the stadium seats, but they are going to still give us the price of \$31.75. We ordered 28 and 15 of those are spoke for.

STEAK NIGHT

The steak night went very well. The boys won the pie auction, so Coach Byrd and Coach Martin will dress as girls at the Homecoming pep rally. The dinners brought in \$295.00,

boys auction was \$1453.50, girls auction was \$1423.50, tips \$460.16, donations \$186.00 for a total of \$3,818.16. 2009 had a total of \$3,121.75 and 2007 totaled \$2,578.95, so we should be very proud of a job well done.

BASEBALL FIELD TARP

The baseball field tarp is here. Wes and Velma Hayes have donated the sand bags needed to hold the tarp down.
