The Vienna Eagles Athletic Booster Club meeting was held on Wednesday, October 13, 2010 in the Maries R-1 cafeteria. SECRETARY'S REPORT

A motion was made by Rolanda Backues to accept the minutes from the September meeting, seconded by Carol Falter. Motion passed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Susan Brunnert distributed copies of the current fiscal year's account activity report. At present, the Club has a total of \$14,626.91 in their combined accounts, with \$5,480.30 in the checking account, \$5,623.93 in the MMDA and \$3,522.68 in the gym account. All bills are paid with the exception of the \$200 set aside for spirit items and the tarp for the baseball field.

MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

Our membership drive has gone really well. We have 47 businesses as members for a total of \$1,350. That is the highest number in five years. We have 33 families as members for a total of \$180. Angie Hayes made a motion to spend up to \$60 for an ad in the paper thanking the businesses and listing all the businesses that are members, seconded by Coach Murray.

We purchased 100 adult shirts and 36 youth shirts. We have sold out of the adult and only have 7 youth shirts left. We are taking orders if anyone would still like to purchase one. We had 42 on the list and received an order for about 20 more. We have made \$272 on the adult shirts so far. We discussed Black out dates being December 14, January 7 and February 8. We will finalize the dates at the next meeting.

DISTRICT SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

The District Softball Tournament was a success. Coach Murray helped organize the event. The gate took in over \$1100 on the last two nights. We ordered 93 shirts and sold out. We made \$312.75 on the shirts. Susan Brunnert organized the t-shirt sales and contacted the schools in advance to have the appropriate sizes available to each team.
