Meeting Minutes

SECRETARY'S REPORT

A motion was made by Mick Byrd to accept the minutes from the August meeting, seconded by Angie Stricklan. Motion passed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Mindy Patton distributed copies of the current fiscal year's account activity report. At present, the Club has a total of \$20,352.95 in their combined accounts, with \$4,145.61 in the checking account, \$12,668.13 in the MMDA and \$3,539.21 in the gym account. The only pending bill is the gold rush t-shirts, which is around \$1700.

STADIUM SEATS

17 people are on the list for stadium seats. There is a minimum order of 28. Susan Brunnert made a motion to purchase the chairs, seconded by Angie Stricklan.

The blankets are in and sell for \$15.

GOLD RUSH T-SHIRTS

We had 266 orders for the gold rush shirts. There was a price break at 300, so we ordered 300. There will be a profit of around \$1200.

ACTION ITEM: We need to get the dates set for the gold rush games. Coach Murray would like to have Dec 9 against Iberia. Coach Murray will decide on the dates and let us know.

EAGLE WEAR

Mindy is not interested in heading the Eagle wear project. She suggested not going with Custom Screen Printing. No one showed an interest in leading this project, so there will be no Eagle wear until possibly next year.

He would like to purchase 15 of the jerseys from Red Weir for a total of \$270. Mick Byrd made a motion to purchase the jerseys, seconded by Ian Murray.

Coach Murray requested to order 20 more baseball caps for a total of \$260. Also, he would like to purchase game balls from Key Sport for a total of \$91.50. Ellie Glick made a motion to accept his request, seconded by Susan Brunnert. He is going to need more bats before January 1st, but would like to wait for a sale.

Coach Byrd would like a scoreboard that works. There are large crowds at the softball games and it would be nice for them to be able to see the score. He had Rusty Wood look at the old board and the circuit board is burnt. The board was purchased 13 years ago used. It is outdated and needs replaced. Nevco estimated a wireless board @ \$844, \$130 repair module, \$30 update plus shipping. A new scoreboard could be bought for about \$4,000. Linda Logan has someone that could possibly give a nice donation towards the scoreboard. The one on the baseball field does not work either. Coach Byrd thought we should replace both of them. Kristan James will ask Maries County Bank if they would like to purchase the new scoreboards since they bought the last ones.
